Madras School of Economics (MSE) invites applications from qualified candidates for faculty positions at the level of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor in Economics, and its allied subjects, with desirable specialization in Development Economics, Applied Econometrics (Time Series), Public Economics, International Trade, etc.

Number of vacancies at MSE:

Assistant Professor: 2 Positions (In specializations specified above)

Associate Professor: 3 Positions (1 Finance, 2 in other specializations specified above)

Professor/Associate Professor: 1 position (Public Economics - Centre for Public Finance)

Qualifications:

Professor:

An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in Economics or allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work, with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed journals. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in Economics or allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in Economics/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Associate Professor:

A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in Economics or allied/relevant disciplines. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) in Economics or allied/relevant disciplines. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed journals.

Assistant Professor:

A full time Ph.D. degree with at least two publications out of which at least one must be in peer reviewed journal. A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Economics or allied/relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

In the case of candidates from foreign universities, the Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

For all the above positions, preference would be given for candidates having publications in ABDC/Scopus/Web of Science journals.

Basic Pay Scales

Professor: Pay Rs. 1,44,200/-

Associate Professor : Pay Rs. 1,31,400/-

Assistant Professor: Pay Rs. 57,700/-

For all above positions, the following are applicable:

(i) HRA. 30% (subject to revision as per Govt. guidelines)

(ii) TA: Rs 1800/-

(iii) DA: 53%(subject to revision as per Govt. guidelines)

(iv) EPF 12% of basic pay and DA

(v) Medical Reimbursement of Rs.12,500/- per annum plus Medical Insurance and Rs. 25,000/ academic grant per year.

In addition, "performance-linked payments and facilities" are provided through provisions for undertaking consultancy assignments/ projects subject to MSE rules.

Madras School of Economics may consider suitable candidates who may not have applied and will have right to fill candidates at lower positions in case suitable candidates are not available for the advertised position.
